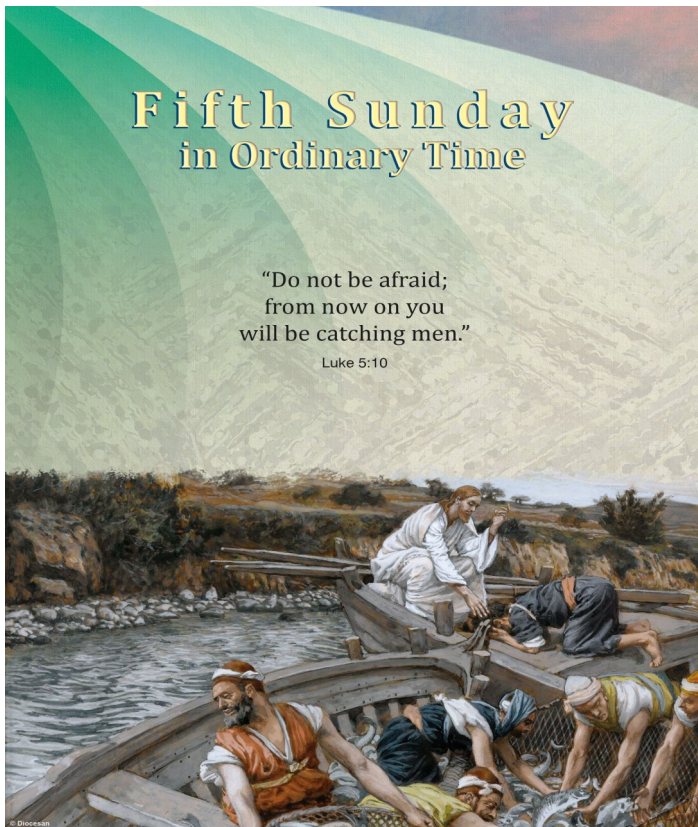


**Catholic Ministries Appeal**
