Suggestions for Gifts

*Please refrain from purchasing any size specific apparel!

- ◆ Adult Women or Adult Men: Hats, scarves, gloves, socks, store gift cards (especially Kroger, IGA, Walgreen's, CVS, etc.), blankets, towels, stationery, watches, purses, wallets, toiletries, items for the home, sausage and cheese boxed gifts.
- ◆ Teens or Pre-Teens: Hats, scarves, gloves, socks, store gift cards, jewelry, nail care kit, personal care items.
- ◆ Children: Hats, scarves, gloves, books, games, toys, dolls, art supplies, sports items.
