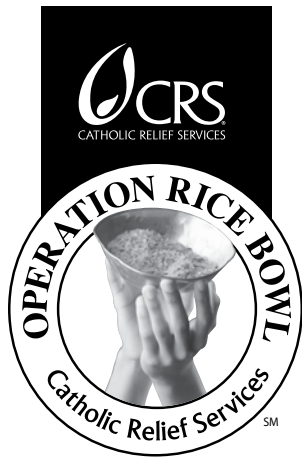

## World Awareness Quiz Answers

1. (a) **925 million people** worldwide are undernourished, which means they are not receiving the minimum amount of food essential for good health. (Bread for the World)
2. (c) 11.5% of children in the world, 101 million, are not enrolled in school. Of these children, 53% are girls. (United Nations)
3. (a) Worldwide, 40% of the population, or more than 2.6 billion people, lack one of life's most basic needs: an adequate **sanitation facility** – defined as one that hygienically prevents human contact with sewage. 13% of the world's population does not have access to clean water. (Bread for the World)
4. (b) 48% of the world's population lives on less than **\$2** per day. 25.2% of the world's population lives in extreme poverty, meaning they live on less than \$1.25 per day.
5. (c) An estimated **16.6 million** children (under age 18) have lost one or both parents to AIDS in 2009 (the most recent year recorded). 14.9 million of these children live in sub-Saharan Africa. (United Nations)
6. (a) Nearly **20%** of the world's population is engaged in agriculture, supporting their families through income generated from farming. (Food and Agriculture Organization)
7. (b) CRS' **microfinance programs** are committed to serving the very poor, especially women and vulnerable populations in remote rural communities. CRS' programs target the self-employed poor who have little or no access to formal credit or savings services.
